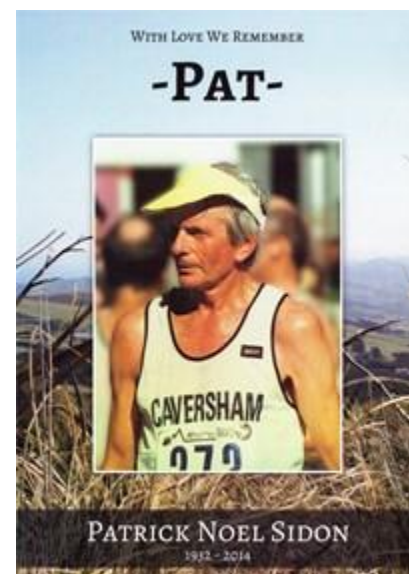

Life Member and Co Patron of the Caversham Harrier and Athletic Club **Pat Sidon** passed away on Tuesday 1st April 2014. Having joined the club in 1948 Pat was a member for 66 years and became one of Otago's top cross-country runners, his long list of achievements included captain of the New Zealand team at the World Cross-Country Championships in 1965. No other runner has come close to Pat's records which include.

- New Zealand Cross-Country representative 1957 - 1965
- New Zealand Cross-Country Junior Champion 1951, Senior Champion 1961
- Otago Cross-Country Champion, 13 senior titles
- Edmond Cup 11 senior titles, 15 teams titles with Caversham
